Schedule **Registration and Launching** will be at Olin Park on John Nolan Drive on Thursday, June 9th from 12:00pm-7:00pm and on Friday from 7:30am-8:30am.

Competitors' Briefing will be held at Olin Park Headquarters and by VHF radio on Friday, June 10th at 8:30am.

Race Schedule Six races are scheduled. The first race is scheduled for a 10:00am warning signal on Friday, June 10. Except when races are sailed back to back, the approximate time of the warning signal for subsequent races will be posted. No races shall start after 12:30pm Sunday June, 12th.

Rules The races will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the Prescriptions of US Sailing and the C Class Scantlings as published in the ILYA Rule Book.

Scoring The low point scoring system, RRS A4 shall apply, except that RRS A2 is changed so that each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races unless six or more races are completed. If six or more races are complete, each boat shall discard her worst score, except when prohibited under RRS 90.3(b).

Eligibility The regatta is open to Class C Scows. Helms-persons MUST be Regular Members of the NCSSA. You can become a member by completing and submitting the NCSSA registration form and fee via the NCSSA website (www.cscow.org), or at registration.

Media Rights Competitors give absolute right and permission for video footage or photographs of themselves or their boat generated during the event to be published in any media for press, editorial or advertising purposes.

Awards NCSSA race winner trophies will be awarded for each race. Trophies will be awarded to the skipper and two crew finishing 1st thru 10th, and the top Master, Junior and Female Skippers.

Moorings Boat mooring will be available south East of the launch at Olin Park – Bring 50' of anchor line, sufficient anchor and buoy.
